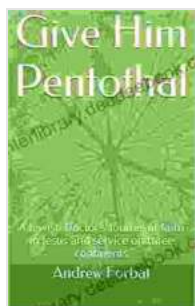


A Jewish Doctor's Journey of Faith in Jesus and Service on Three Continents

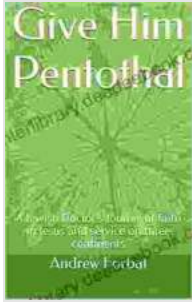

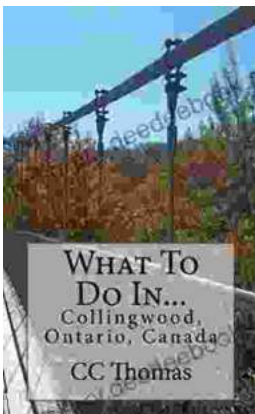

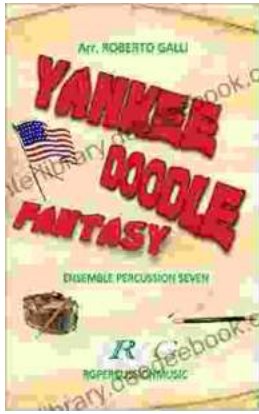
