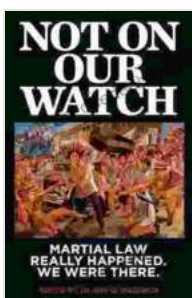


Not On Our Watch: A Humanitarian Organization Fighting Atrocities

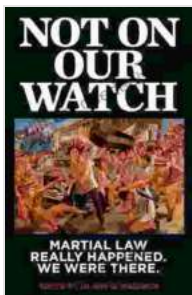
