

"I don't think so," said Squeaky. "My tummy hurts."


"I know what will help," said the rubber frog. "Let's take you to the doctor."

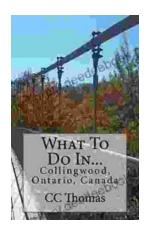

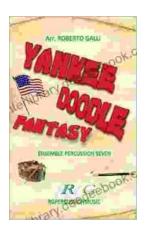
