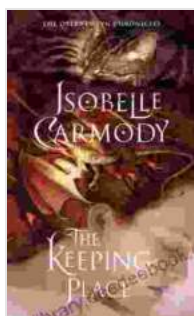


The Keeping Place: A Journey into the Obernewtyn Chronicles

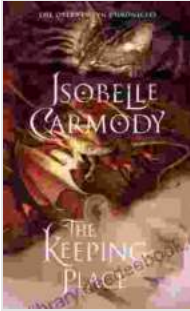

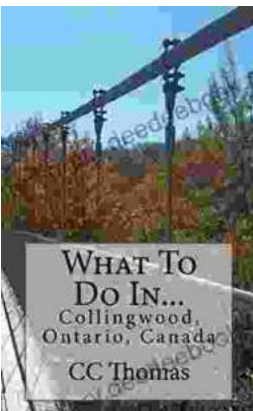
